 - Dock in historic Clarkston, Washington at the confluence of the Snake & Clearwater Rivers. A motorcoach will transfer us upriver where we board covered jet boats for an exhilarating excursion into Hells Canyon, North America's deepest canyon.
 - In Walla Walla, enjoy a historic tour & wine tasting at two unique wineries.
- Enjoy a full day of leisurely cruising past ancient petroglyphs, granite and basalt cliffs, Beacon Rock, Multnomah Falls, Cape Horn and legendary Rooster Rock.
- In Astoria, visit the Fort Clatsop National Memorial & the fascinating Columbia River Maritime Museum. Discover the hidden treasures of this charming Victorian seaport, that is the western terminus of the TransAmerica Trail.
