

## **CAMEO MEMBERSHIP**

### *Responsibilities and Privileges of Membership*

- *Members must be employed when they join.*
- *Prospective new members will attend an Informational meeting which features an overview of all elements of the CAMEO Professional Auxiliary.*
- *Members will serve a period of orientation and training for one year.*
- *Members attend all mandatory and informational meetings that deal in depth with topics such as:*

*Assistance League of Long Beach  
CAMEO Philanthropic Project/Mentoring  
CAMEO policies and procedures*

- *Members are required to attend six of the nine monthly General Meetings. CAMEO is dark during the months of July, August, and December.*
- *Members will meet their financial obligations which include \$85 yearly dues and a \$25 orientation fee for first year members.*
- *CAMEO members serve as a mentor of a high school student or a LBCC woman after the first year of orientation and training.*
- *Members participate in the annual fundraising event, The Fashion Show. Each member is responsible for selling a minimum of two reservations and is also encouraged to provide auction items either solicited or purchased.*
- *Members need to be fingerprinted once and must provide a current valid driver's license and auto insurance certificate yearly in order to mentor students.*
- *Each member is required to serve on at least one committee and is encouraged to hold a Governing Board position in the future.*
- *Time commitments each month include one General Meeting, one evening committee meeting, and one monthly mentoring activity with your student.*
