



CAMEO MEMBERSHIP

Responsibilities and Privileges of Membership

- Members must be employed when they join.
- Prospective new members will attend an Informational meeting which features an overview of all elements of the CAMEO Professional Auxiliary.
- Members will serve a period of orientation and training for one year.
- Members attend all mandatory and informational meetings that deal in depth with topics such as:

Assistance League of Long Beach
CAMEO Philanthropic Project/Mentoring
CAMEO policies and procedures

- Members are required to attend six of the nine monthly General Meetings. CAMEO is dark during the months of July, August, and December.
- Members will meet their financial obligations which include \$100 yearly dues and a \$25 orientation fee for first year members.
- CAMEO members serve as a mentor of a high school student or a LBCC woman after the first year of orientation and training.
- Members participate in the annual fundraising event, The Fashion Show. Each member is responsible for selling a minimum of two reservations and is also encouraged to provide auction items either solicited or purchased.
- Members need to be fingerprinted once and must provide a current valid driver's license and auto insurance certificate yearly in order to mentor students.
- Each member is required to serve on at least one committee and is encouraged to hold a Governing Board position in the future.
- Time commitments each month include one General Meeting, one evening committee meeting, and one monthly mentoring activity with your student.
