



ASSISTEENS AUXILIARY SERVICE RESPONSIBILITIES

Recording & Reporting Hours

Members shall record and report all service hours to the Membership Chairman. For the purpose of report hours the fiscal year shall be divided into quarters as follows:

- June through August
- September through November
- December through February
- March through May

Regular Meetings

Members shall attend nine (9) regular meetings, including the annual meeting, per year. Attendance is required at a minimum of seven (7) meetings.

- June
- September
- October
- November
- January
- February
- March
- April
- May (annual meeting)

Service Hours

In addition to regular meetings, members shall annually serve a minimum of 30 (thirty) service hours in Assisteens, chapter or other auxiliary activities and philanthropic programs, and/or thrift shop placements.

Fundraising

Assisteens must participate in on one (1) annual fundraiser. A "Buy-Out" option is offered typically the "Buy-Out" cost is \$50 per Assisteen.

Class Philanthropic Programs

Members of each class (grade) shall plan and participate in one program per year. Participation is required as follows:

- Senior Class – Adopt-a-Family
- Junior Class – Senior Prom
- Sophomore Class – Operation School Bell/Crayon and Pencil drive
- Freshman Class – Operation Shoe Box
