Responsibilities and Privileges of CAMEO Membership

- New Members will serve a period of orientation and training for one year. They may co-mentor with a current mentor during that time.
- New Members will serve on the Education committee in their first year. During that time, they will learn about the Assistance League of Long Beach and its philanthropies, CAMEO philanthropy (mentoring) and CAMEO resource development (Fashion Show).
- Members will meet their financial obligations. Membership Dues for the first year are \$125. This includes membership dues, new member fee, and a Background Check (needed for mentoring). Membership dues thereafter are \$100 per year.
- Members serve as a mentor of a high school student or a LBCC woman after the first year of orientation and training.
- Members need to be fingerprinted once and must provide a current valid driver's license and auto insurance certificate yearly.
- Members participate in the annual fundraising event, the Fashion Show. Each member is responsible for selling a minimum of 2 reservations and is also encouraged to provide auction items either solicited or purchased.
- Members are required to serve on at least one committee and are encouraged to hold a Governing Board position in the future.
- Members must attend one General meeting per month (typically Saturday morning), as well as one monthly mentoring activity with your student.
